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








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
Lesson 1 - Passion

"Nothing great in the world has been accomplished without passion" (Hegel, 1832).


Lesson 2 – Focus on Your Strengths

- Do personal improvement on your own time!



Lesson 8 – Champion the Testing Effort


- Get involved

- Experience burn out


